#### **Course Information**

- > The language of instruction at PHTG is mainly German. The minimum level of ability in the language of instruction is B2.

- > Students with little or no knowledge of the German language are requested to attend a German course throughout the semester or take part in an intensive German course at the beginning of their stay (subject to availability). Furthermore, an intensive German language course is offered by the Lake Constance Summer School each year in August which is eligible for funding (ERAS-MUS students only!).
